Dr. UTTARA CHATTERJEE



Prof. Uttara Chatterjee is currently working as a professor in the department of Pathology at the Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education & Research (IPGME&R), Kolkata. She has been a faculty of this institute for the last 25 years.

She did her MBBS from Maulana Azad Medical College and MD Pathology from AIIMS, New Delhi in 1991. She trained at St. Mary's Hospital, Manchester in 1992-1993. Her special areas of interests are Pediatric and Neuropathology and has published more than 200 research papers in national and international journals as well as several book chapters. She is a member of the editorial board of Indian Journal of Pathology and Microbiology (IJPM). She has organized various conferences and CMEs and has been the organizing secretary of an international CME on pediatric pathology in January 2019. She arranged a workshop on perinatal and fetal autopsy techniques in January 2019 as part of the pre-conference workshop.

She has done a number of extra-mural research projects and has been a guide for PhD thesis, DM, MCH as well as MD and MS thesis and has been a co-guide in thesis from Gynae and Obs, Anatomy, Radiology, Neonatology, Pediatric Surgery and Neurosurgery departments. She has delivered several talks as guest lecturer at various CME and conferences which include APCON, Jaipur (2016); APCON, Bhopal (2017); APCON, Bareilly (2018) and moderated a slide seminar session on pediatric soft tissue neoplasms as part of IAP-ID program at PGI, Chandigarh (2019). She also moderated a CME session on Neoplastic and Non neoplastic lesions of the adrenal gland on a virtual mode in APCON Raipur in 2021. She has been nominated as a member for the revision of MD pathology curriculum by the National Medical Council.

She also a keen traveler and dabbles in veterinary surgical pathology from time to time, the details of which she says she cannot share!

Dr. Kirti Chadha is a gold medallist from Armed Forces Medical College in Pune, India. She has over two decades of rich experience in Diagnostics & Theranostics and is currently the Chief Scientific Officer at Metropolis Healthcare. Prior to Metropolis, she was associated with renowned hospitals such as Tata Memorial Hospital, PD Hinduja Hospital, Sir Ganga Ram Hospital and other Centres of Excellence. Dr. Kirti curated the Research & Development, Academics & Innovation wing to enable Metropolis offer 1st and best-in-class technology and test profiles for cost effective accurate diagnostics. She has been actively involved in forming a Medical Advisory Board by empanelling experts in the healthcare industry. With her valuable support and guidance, Metropolis has been successfully driving its prestigious CSR initiative 'MedEngage' - which extends scholarships, academic grants and research support for young doctors undergoing training.

The Annual Conference 2021 of the IAP – Indian Division was held on 2nd December 2021 in virtual format organized by the Chhattisgarh Chapter of IAPM at Raipur, Chhattisgarh. 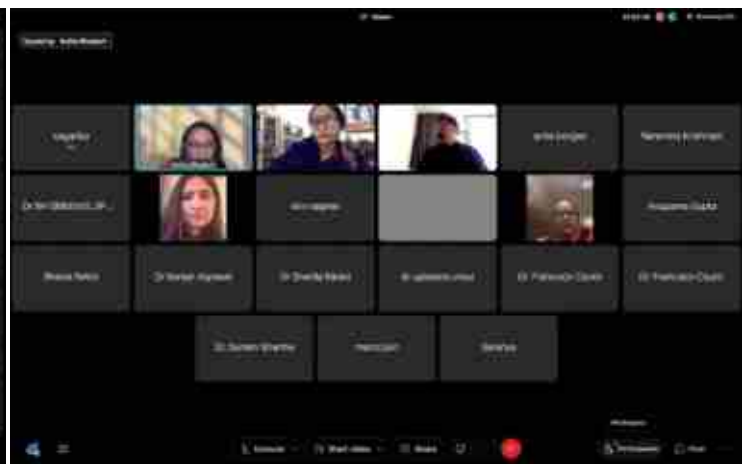
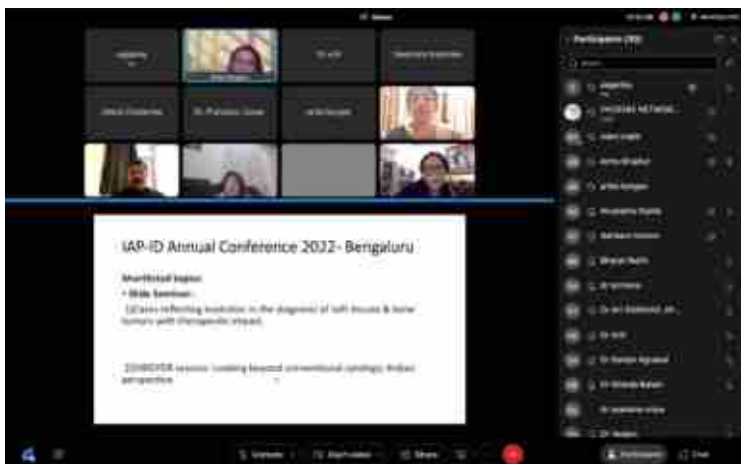
President of the IAP-ID Dr. Anita Bhaduri chaired the Meeting and called the Meeting to order and welcomed the members.
