Guest Speaker for IAP-ID Annual Meeting 2013 - Aurangabad

This year for the IAP-ID Annual Meeting 2013 at Aurangabad, Maharastra, on 12th December our invited Guest Speaker will be **Prof. Dr. Aileen Wee**, MBBS, FRCPA,FRCPath, Professor &S enior Consultant, Department of Pathology, Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, National University of Singapore, Singapore. The IAP-ID is honoured to have Prof. Aileen Wee attend our meeting as the invited Guest Speaker. A brief biodata of Prof. Aileen Wee is given here under for the benefit of the members:



Professor Aileen Wee, MBBS, FRCPath, FRCPA, is Professor and Senior Consultant at the Department of Pathology, Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, National University of Singapore, National University Hospital, National University Health System.

Dr. Aileen Wee graduated from the University of Singapore in 1975 with

MBBS. She trained in Histopathology at the Department of Pathology, NUS, and obtained her specialist degree in Histopathology from the Royal Colleges of Pathologists in Australasia and the United Kingdom in 1981 and 1982, respectively.

She is a member of the American Association for the Study of Liver Diseases and the Laennec Liver Pathology Society.

Dr. Aileen Wee's research interests include hepatobiliary pathology and fine needle aspiration cytology of the liver. She is currently working on developing the potential of qFibrosis - a fully automated, computer-assisted, stain-free imaging technology for global liver architectural evaluation and quantitative assessment of different patterns of liver fibrosis.

She is a reviewer and advisor on several regional/international journals, and has published over 100 articles in peer-reviewed journals.

Prof. Aileen Wee is co-author of several books/chapters on liver cytopathology including Fine needle aspiration cytology of the liver. Diagnostic Algorithms. A Southeast Asian perspective. Bangkok: Year Book Publisher, 2004; Handbook of Immunohistochemistry and in situ hybridization of Human Carcinomas, Volume 3. MolecularGenetics, Liver Carcinoma, and Pancreatic Carcinoma. London: Elsevier, 2005.; WHO Classification of Tumours of the Digestive System, IARC: Lyon 2010.; MacSween's Pathology of the Liver, 6th edition, Churchill Livingstone, 2012.;Odze's Surgical Pathology of GIT, Liver, Biliary Tract and Pancreas (in press).; and, Liver Cytohistology in the series "Cytohistology of Small Tissue Samples", Papanicolaou Society of Cytopathology in association with Cambridge University Press (in press).

Prof. Aileen Wee organizes Diagnostic Cytopathology Workshops and has travelled extensively in the region and internationally to deliver invited lectures at scientific meetings and to conduct cytopathology and hepatobiliary workshops.

She was past Director of Undergraduate Pathology Teaching and Phase II Co-ordinator for the medical undergraduate

programme at Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine.

She was past Chair of the Specialist Training Committee (Pathology) and was a member of the Specialist Accreditation Board, Singapore.

Prof. Aileen Wee received the National University of Singapore Faculty of Medicine Teaching Excellence Award (1997/1998). She was conferred the 2009 Singapore Society of Pathology-Becton Dickinson Award for Pathology.

IAP-ID Mid Year Teaching Programme 2013 - Lucknow



The Mid Year Teaching Programme of the International Academy of Pathology - Indian Division was held on Liquid Based Cytology: Gynaec and Non-Gynaec Applications from 5th to 7th July 2013. The event was organized by the Department of Pathology Dr Ram Manohar Lohia Institute of Medical Sciences Lucknow (RMLIMS) in the form of a 2 day CME at the Indira Gandhi Pratishthan, Lucknow and one day parallel workshops at the Department of Pathology at RMLIMS. Dr. Nuzhat Husain, Dean and Head of Department of Pathology, RMLIMS was the Organizing Secretary. The Chief Guest was Mr. Jawed Usmani, IAS (Chief Secretary of Uttar Pradesh) who inaugurated the event in the presence of other dignitaries Prof Francisco Couto, Vice President of International Academy of Pathology who was the Guest of Honor; Mr. J. P. Shama (Principal Secretary, Medical Education, Government of Uttar Pradesh), Dr. Shantveer G Uppin (Secretary & Treasurer) representing the IAP-ID; Dr. Nuzhat Husain (Organizing Secretary) and Prof. KusumVerma (New Delhi) who delivered the Key note address on "Overview of Liquid Based Cytology". The proceedings of the CME as well as Manual for both the workshops were released at the inaugural function. The Programme was well attended with 247 delegates from all over the country.

The organizing secretary Prof Nuzhat Husain was strengthened in her endeavor to organize the event by her team of colleagues including Dr. Pradyumn Singh who was the joint organizing secretary. The scientific program was a runaway success with useful and relevant topics covered by renowned faculty including Prof Kusum Verma, who also delivered the keynote address and a lecture on LBC and respiratory

Cytology, Prof Radhika Srinivasan spoke on LBC of effusions and Dr. Nalini Gupta also from PGIMER discussed audits in LBC as well as covered glandular lesions in Gynaec cytology. Dr. Sandeep Mathur from AIIMS, New Delhi explained LBC of squamous neoplasia , Dr. Ramani Kumar from CMC Vellore spoke on LBC of Urine as well as quality control issues. Prof M. M. Goel from KGMU compared LBC and conventional cytology, while Prof Ravi Malhotra discussed aspects of cervical cancer screening, Prof. Neeta Kumar covered ancillary techniques in LBC of gynaec lesions. The faculty from RMLIMS, also participated in the scientific program with interesting cases and lectures. Slide seminars on Gynaec and Non-gynaec lesions were held and had an array of rare and interesting cases. The conference venue had an excellent ambiance and the organizers also displayed e-slides at the internet hub. The e-courses have been uploaded at the telepathology weblink at the institute website www.drrmlims.ac.in and the power points from the slide seminar is also available at the website. Series of video recorded lectures will also be serially uploaded for benefit of members who could not attend. A large medical book exhibition was also held and provided an array of latest pathology and other publications. Two parallel hands on workshops on the 7th were well attended by 60 delegates. Workshop A co-ordinated by DrVandanaTiwari demonstrated real time and conventional PCR with lectures on HPV detection. Workshop B showed hands on DNA ploidy in flowcytometry and was co-ordinated by Dr. Namrata Awasthi. The workshop participants also viewed glass slides of LBC independently which were discussed together with the experts. Overall, the event was an excellent learning experience for delegates and extremely well organized by Dr. Nuzhat Husain and her team.
