Prof. Henry D. Tazelaar, MD is currently Professor of Laboratory Medicine & Pathology at Mayo Clinic College of Medicine, Consultant, Division of Anatomic Pathology and Chair, Department of Laboratory Medicine/Pathology, Mayo Clinic, Scottsdale, Arizona, USA.

He did his MD from Rush Medical College, and did his Internship in Pathology, Residency in Pathology and Fellowship in Surgical Pathology from Stanford University Medical Centre. He is American Board of Pathology certified in Anatomic Pathology.

Dr. Tazelaar has received several honours and awards during his student days and in his Medical career including, Dr. John W. Brink Memorial Scholarship in 1976-77 (Calvin College), Sir William Osler Pathology Award for Excellence

in Pathology in 1983 (Rush Medical College), Postdoctoral Fellowship - American Lung Association in 1985-86, National Research Service Award - National Institutes of Health in 1985-86, President's Award - International Society for Cardiac Transplantation in 1991 and Charles Carrington Memorial Lectureship - Stanford University in 2008.

Dr. Tazelaar is a member of several professional organizations like American Medical Association, Society for Cardiovascular Pathology, College of American Pathologists, International Society for Heart and Lung Transplantation, International Association for Study of Lung Cancer, United States and Canadian Academy of Pathology and International Academy of Pathology. He has held several positions in Pulmonary Pathology Society including that of Secretary, Treasurer, Vice-President and President.

Dr. Tazelaar has been invited speaker at several International Congresses, national and regional meetings. He has been Course Director for several courses on Pulmonary and Cardiac Pathology and Mentored several Visiting Clinicians in Pulmonary Pathology.

Dr. Tazelaar is an accomplished writer and has more than 300 peer reviewed publications in prestigious International Journals, has written 3 Books and contributed chapters to nearly 50 books. He is editorial board member of several prestigious journals like Human Pathology, Modern Pathology, Archives of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine and South West Journal of Pulmonary and Critical Care.

The event was organized by Anand Diagnostic Laboratory, Bengaluru in the form of one day CME at The Capitol Hotel, Bengaluru and one day Workshop at Anand Diagnostic Laboratory, Bengaluru. Dr. N.
