MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT




Dear Friends

Dr. C. Sundaram, M.D, FAMS, FICPath did her graduation (1978) and post graduation in Pathology (1983) from Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam. She joined Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences in 1986 and is currently Senior Professor and Head of the Department of Pathology. She had training in Neuropathology in UK and attended several workshops and courses in Neuromuscular disorders. Her research interests include Neuromuscular diseases with emphasis on Mitochondrial diseases, Neurooncology with particular reference to signal transduction pathways in gliomas. Her other interests include Infections particularly fungal infections of CNS, Endocrine pathology and Mediastinum. She is an active member of Indian Association of Pathologists and Microbiologists (IAPM) and IAP-ID and held various responsible positions in the associations. She is an Associate Editor of IJPM and Neurology India. She has about 125 publications in peer reviewed journals. She

contributed chapters in 10 books and monograms. She is a member of various professional bodies. She has trained several students in Pathology, Neurology and Neurosurgery. She participates actively in various CMEs, Slide Seminars and Symposia as an invited faculty.

Dr. Nirmala Ajit Jambhekar, MBBS, DPB, MD, is currently the Head & Professor of Pathology, Department of Surgical Pathology, Tata Memorial Hospital Mumbai, India's premier Cancer Institute. She did her MBBS and MD from the Sir J J Hospital & Grant Medical College, Mumbai, through the Bombay University and her DPB from the College of Physicians & Surgeons, Mumbai. Dr. Jambhekar has large number of publications and research work totaling more than 110 (excluding abstracts). Dr. Nirmal Jambhekar has been on the panels and contributed to the WHO Blue Books on Lung tumours, 1999; Bone & Soft tissue tumours, 2002; and Lung & Mediastinal Pathology, 2004. She has participated in American Thoracic Society / European respiratory Society International Multidisciplinary Consensus classification of Idiopathic Interstitial Pneumonias: Am J Respir Crit Care Med 2002. A THANK YOU MESSAGE FROM THE OUT GOING PRESIDENT DR. FRANCISCO COUTO

My dear friends,



I wish to thank each one of you most profusely and most sincerely for all the love, affection and support you have shown me for the past nearly 14 years during which I was at the helm of affairs at our very much esteemed International Academy of Pathology – Indian Division (IAP-ID) having been your President for the last two years (2009 & 2010) and earlier for more than 11 years as the Secretary & Treasurer (1997 to 2008) and the Editor IAP-ID Newsletter (1997 to 2008).

From a small organization when I took over in 1997 the IAP – Indian Division has now grown into one of the most vibrant, active and respected Divisions of the International Academy of Pathology (IAP). It has indeed been my honour and privilege to serve you as the President, Secretary & Treasurer and Editor of the Newsletter of the IAP-ID. It was only because of your support and help that I was able to achieve so many achievements and bring the IAP-ID to the present high level and leave it on a sound and firm base from where, I am sure, even further progress and enhancements will be done.

When I took over as Secretary & Treasurer, in November 1997, our Division was a fairly small organization which has grown tremendously over the years having large number of members now and with many more keen to join. There has also been a great fillip in the academic activities with more and more members wanting to participate actively which is indeed a very happy and satisfying development. There have been high quality scientific programmes and many eminent foreign speakers and those from India have participated in the IAP-ID meetings. Besides the continuation of the earlier activity of the Mid Year Teaching Programme and the Annual Conference, with the active support and advice of the then President, Surgeon Rear Admiral P. Sivadas, I was able to start a new academic activity, namely the IAP-ID Annual CME, which has become very popular and is going from strength to strength. This has benefited the IAP-ID in many ways and in many areas. It was very gratifying that after pursuing the matter with the authorities of the International Academy of Pathology (IAP), they conceded to my point that the Indian Division, as per the provisions of the constitution of the IAP, was entitled to two Council Members to represent the Indian Division as members of the International Council of the IAP; subsequently, this has been implemented by the IAP since 1998. Also, in my capacity as member of the Education Committee of the IAP and as a Councillor of the International Council of the IAP I have been able to high light various issue of importance and the promote the best interests of the Indian Division of the IAP and have been able to enhance the profile and importance given to the IAP-ID in the IAP and its various international fora. IAP-ID Thanks Dr. Couto


