GUEST SPEAKER FOR IAP-ID ANNUAL MEETING 2006

This year for the IAP-ID Annual Meeting 2006 at Bangalore our invited Guest Speaker will be Dr. Runjan Chetty, Professor of Pathology, Department of Laboratory Medicine and Pathobiology, University of Toronto, Ontario, Canada. As Dr. Chetty's biodata has already featured before in the Newsletter a brief update of the biodata is given here under for the benefit of the members:



Dr. Runjan Chetty is currently the Professor of Pathology, Department of Laboratory Medicine and Pathobiology, University of Toronto; Director of Surgical Pathology, University Health Network & Toronto Medical Laboratories, Toronto, Ontario, Canada; and Director Residency and Fellowship Program, University of Toronto.

Born in 1957, Dr. Runjan Chetty did his school education from Dublin (Ireland), London (United

Kingdom) and Durban (South Africa). His medical education was at the Royal College of Surgeons, in Ireland, from October 1976 to June 1982. Dr. Chetty excelled in his studies and was the winner of the Arthur Jacobs Open Scholarship, Royal College of Surgeons, Ireland, and achieved honours in Biology, Physics, Pathology, Microbiology, Ophthalmology, Psychiatry, Forensic Medicine, and the first prize and medal in Social & Preventive Medicine.

He is highly qualified with a string of degrees namely MB, BCh, BaO, LRCP, LRCS from Royal College of Surgeons / National University, Ireland; FFPath (South Africa); FRCPA (Australasia); FFPath (Royal College of Physicians, Ireland); FRCPath (Royal College of Pathologists, United Kingdom); FRCPC (Royal College of Physicians of Canada); FCAP (College of American Pathologists); and DPhil (St. John's College, University of Oxford, United Kingdom). He is registered with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, Canada; Health Professions Council of South Africa; General Medical Council, United Kingdom; and the Medical Board of Queensland, Australia.

He has worked in various capacities in various parts of the world like South Africa, Australia, United Kingdom and now Canada. His main area of expertise includes General Surgical Pathology, Frozen sections, Immunohistochemistry, Immunofluorescence, Electron microscopy, and, Molecular biology. He has also performed 650 autopsies and is involved in Under- and Post-graduate teaching.


Dr. Runjan Chetty is currently the editor in chief of Journal of Clinical Pathology and Molecular Pathology. He is on the editorial board of: Pathology, Current Diagnostic Pathology, Endocrine Pathology and International Journal of Surgical Pathology. He is also an ad hoc referee for a large number of Journals namely Journal of Infectious Disease, Australian and New Zealand Journal of Surgery, Pathology, Annals of Oncology, International Journal of Cancer, Journal of Clinical Pathology, Oncology, South African Journal of Surgery, South African Journal of Medicine, British Journal of Cancer, British Medical Journal, Journal of Pathology, Histopathology, Anti-Cancer Journal, Clinical Cancer Research, American Journal of Dermatopathology, The Journal of Postgraduate Medicine, and Modern Pathology.

Dr. Chetty has presented scientific presentations at several congresses of the IAP in South Africa and Australia, the Pathological Society of Great Britain and Ireland, the Royal College of Pathologists of Australasia annual meeting and the South African Pulmonology Society annual congress. Dr. Runjan Chetty is a popular speaker and has been the invited guest speaker for a large number of talks and seminars all over the world. Dr. Chetty is a prolific writer and has 225 scientific publications in various Journals. He has also been a contributor to Books and Book chapters like being a Contributor to the WHO Classification of Tumours: Pathology and Genetics of Tumours of Endocrine Organs and a Chapter on Thyroid Lymphomas in the book titled Molecular Basis of Thyroid Cancer. He is an active member of many Pathology Societies and Associations.

Dr. Runjan Chetty's areas of interest include General Surgical Pathology, especially gastrointestinal, endocrine, cardiorespiratory, haemato-pathology and general tumour pathology; Immunohistochemistry; and Molecular biology.

OBITUARY



Dr. Nalini Venugopal

It is with deepest regret and sadness that I announce the passing away of Prof. Nalini Venugopal one of the eminent members of the IAP-ID and its past Secretary & Treasurer (1984-1988).

Prof. Nalini Venugopal was born in 30th December 1944 and did her M.B;B.S from

Christian Medical College, Vellore, in 1967 and then her MD in Pathology from the Kasturba Medical College, Manipal, in 1974. In her long and distinguished career Dr. Nalini Venugopal worked in many Institutions starting from the Kasturba Medical College, Manipal, where she joined as Tutor in Pathology in 1971 and was subsequently Assistant Professor in 1975, Reader in 1976, Associate Professor in 1981 and then Professor of Pathology from 1984 to June 1993. She then was the Chief Pathologist at the P.V. S Hospital, Calicut, from June 1993 to October 1996; Chief Pathologist at Pushpagiri Hospital, Tiruvalla, from November 1996 to May 1999. She then joined as the Head of Department of Histopathology & Cytopathology at K.L.E Society's Hospital & Medical Research Centre, Belgaum, in June 1999, and subsequently joined as the Professor and Head of Pathology at Fr. Muller's Medical College, Mangalore, were she worked till the end of 2004. She then joined the AJ Institute of Medical Sciences, Mangalore, as Professor of Pathology in January 2005. At all these institutions Dr. Nalini Venugopal distinguished herself and left an indelible mark not only in these Institutions but on her students, colleagues and the Pathology fraternity at large.

Dr. Nalini Venugopal served several professional bodies and was an active member of the International Academy of Pathology – Indian Division (IAP-ID) and served as its Secretary & Treasurer from 1984 to 1988. On behalf of the IAP-ID I would like to place on record our appreciation and thanks for the immense contributions of Dr. Nalini Venugopal to the IAP-ID. Dr. Nalini Venugopal was also a Life Member of the Indian Academy of Cytologists (IAC) and served as its Executive Committee member from 1992 to 1995. She was also a Life Member of the Indian Association of Pathologists & Microbiologists (IAPM), member of Indian Medical Association (IMA) and Associate Member of Urological Society of India.

Dr. Nalini Venugopal was a regular and active participant in various Pathology Conferences at the state and national level and was chairperson at many of these Conferences. She has conducted Slide Seminars, academic programmes and delivered orations at various areas of Pathology including Cytopathology at the national level. Dr. Nalini Venugopal was the Joint Organizing Secretary for the national IAPM Conference held in Manipal in 1984 and was also the Organizing Secretary of the national IAC Conference at Manipal in 1992. She published several papers in national and international Journals and was a past Editorial Committee member of the Indian Journal of Pathology & Microbiology and was currently an Editorial Committee member of the Journal of Cytology. She was also a gifted teacher having taught many generations of undergraduate and post graduate students and was also an examiner in Pathology for several Universities.

Dr. Nalini Venugopal was not only an eminent Pathologist she was an extremely nice, kind and gentle person and an excellent human being. She will be sorely missed by all. On behalf of the IAP-ID and all of us I extend our heartfelt condolences to her husband Prof. P. Venugopal (an eminent Urologist) and the rest of the family and also our prayers. May her soul rest in peace.
