The IAP-ID is honored to have Prof. Dr. Jane Dahlstrom attend our meeting as the invited Guest Speaker. Born and raised in Sydney Australia, Prof. Dr. Jane Dahlstrom is a medical graduate of the University of Sydney, Australia. After completing her PhD at the John Curtin School of Medical Research at the Australian National University (ANU) she entered speciality training in Anatomical Pathology. She is a Fellow of the Royal College of Pathologists of Australasia (RCPA) in Anatomical Pathology and in Oral Pathology and is a founding Fellow of the Faculty of Science of RCPA. Prof. Jane Dahlstrom was admitted as a Senior Fellow of the Higher Education Academy (SFHEA) in 2014. In 2019 she was awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM) (General Division) within the Australian honours system.

Prof. Dahlstrom is passionate about assisting pathologists from underserved regions of the world. Being chair of the Education Committee of International Academy of Pathology (IAP), President of the Australasian Division of the IAP, immediate past Vice President Asia-Pacific of IAP and immediate past president of the International Paediatric Pathology Association (IPPA) has enabled her to help promote collaborative educational activities of pathologists within these regions.

Prof. Jane Dahlstrom has also held a number of honorary positions within RCPA since 1999 including Chair of the Board of Education and Chair of the Cancer Services Advisory Committee. She is an examiner for RCPA in Anatomical Pathology and Oral Pathology. Since 2004 Jane have been involved in the Australian Medical Council (AMC) accreditation teams assessing medical schools and medical colleges. Past positions include interim (inaugural) Dean of the College of Health and Medicine at ANU from 2017-2019.

Prof. Dr. Jane Dahlstrom has a keen interest in medical education and has won multiple institutional and national awards for her teaching. She is a regular invited speaker at international and national scientific meetings. Jane was the 2018 RCPA visiting lecturer to overseas. She has published over 130 peer reviewed original research articles, reviews, editorials, and book chapters. Her research basis is both clinical and experimental including areas of breast and perinatal pathology, developmental pathology and immunohistochemistry.

Prof. Dr. Jane Dahlstrom is currently Executive Director of ACT Pathology, Canberra Health Services, Senior Staff Specialist in Anatomical Pathology at ACT Pathology and Chair and Professor of Pathology, College of Health and Medicine at ANU.

Those members desirous of organizing and hosting the above workshop or Annual CME should send their proposals and its theme in the formats uploaded on the website IAP-ID - International Academy of Pathology - Indian Division to the Secretary & Treasurer, Dr. Anita S. Bhaduri (address on website). For the Annual Conference 2020 (held along with IAPM Conference) those desirous of being Moderators for Slide seminar or Symposium should send their names along with the proposed titles to the Secretary and treasurer, IAP-ID. As per the decision of the General Body certain topics may be suggested as possible subjects for Slide seminar and Symposium. However, as per the decision of the Council and General Body of the IAP-ID, the person selected as moderator shall be the one who is felt to be best suited for the particular topic of Slide seminar and/or Symposium. All proposals should reach the Secretary & Treasurer, IAP-ID, in prescribed formats latest by 15th October 2019, so as the same proposals could be discussed and approved by the Council and General Body.

IAP MEETINGS AT USCAP 2019

The IAP Education Committee Meeting was held on 17th March 2019 at the 108th Annual Meeting of USCAP held at Gaylord National Resort and Convention Center, National Harbor, Maryland, USA. Dr. Francisco Couto, IAP Vice President, attended the meeting. At the meeting Dr. Francisco Couto was presented a special Certificate of Appreciation at the hands of Dr. Dietmar Schmidt (President, IAP) and Dr. Jane Dahlstrom (Chairperson, Education Committee of IAP) for his enormous contribution to the Education Committee and the wider Pathology community during his tenure at the IAP Education committee.
